TOUR CONDITIONS

TRIP PRICE INCLUDES: Estimated airfare, without taxes, from & returning to, Newark, NJ. Accommodations for nine nights on a share/room basis with full English breakfast daily, four dinners & two lunches, taxes, VAT and service charges (gratuities) at the hotel for housekeeping and meals, plus entrance fees to sites listed.

TRIP PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE: Airfare tax, additional meals while on the trip and items of a personal nature such as alcoholic and bar beverages, phone calls, room service, tips to guides and drivers, or any other items not included in the trip price.

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSITS: In order to confirm a reservation, each participant must submit the completed reservation request form and a non-refundable deposit check in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) made payable to GOING PLACES. Sorry we cannot accept credit cards for this trip.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: A second deposit of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per person is due by April 29, 2011. Final payment for the trip is due by July 29, 2011. The donation of \$100 per person will be paid by Going Places to Kirkridge after final payments have been received by us.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS: Regardless of the reason, cancellations result in costly charges from travel and hotel providers imposing penalties and fees. Therefore, the following policy will apply: Participant must cancel in writing. The effective date of cancellation becomes the date upon which Going Places receives said **written** cancellation. The initial deposit of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per person is non-refundable. The second deposit of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per person is fully refundable until July 29, 2011. All cancellations received between July 29, 2011 and departure become subject to 100% penalty (based on the total air/land package cost)
